

Installation Instructions for HighRoad With a Stand Alone Copy Protection Device

The following instructions describe how to install your software and Copy Protection Device on your Windows 95/98/Me/NT/2000/XP machine.

- 1) If your Copy Protection Device is a parallel port device it must be plugged into your Printer port (LPT port) and the screws must be securely tightened before you install the software. Any cables that are currently plugged into the Printer port can be plugged into the Copy Protection Device and they will continue to function properly. Please turn off your machine before plugging in the Copy Protection Device to prevent damage to the device and your computer.

If your Copy Protection Device is a USB device it must be plugged into one of your USB ports before you install the software.

- 2) If you are using Windows NT/2000/XP, ensure that you are logged on with Administrator privileges to allow the Copy Protection Device drivers to be installed into the System directory. Windows 95/98/Me users need take no special action.
- 3) Insert the CD into the CD drive of your computer. The Installation program should start up automatically. If it does not, double click the file **Setup.exe** in the CD root directory.
- 4) Click on the Install Programs button and follow the instructions on the screen.
- 5) After HighRoad is installed, click on the HighRoad Hasp Installer button to install the required Copy Protection Device files.
- 6) HighRoad can print directly to Postscript printers. To allow HighRoad to print to other Windows compatible printers you should install GNU Ghostscript on your computer by clicking on the GhostScript button.
- 7) The first time you run the software you will be asked for an Authentication key and Serial number. These numbers are on the Access Code - Password form included with your order.
