

# **Module Update Instructions for HighRoad With a Stand Alone Copy Protection Device**

The following instructions describe how to update your software for new HighRoad modules on your Windows 95/98/Me/NT/2000/XP machine.

- 1) If your Copy Protection Device is a parallel port device it must be plugged into your Printer port (LPT port) and the screws must be securely tightened before you install the software. Any cables that are currently plugged into the Printer port can be plugged into the Copy Protection Device and they will continue to function properly. Please turn off your machine before plugging in the Copy Protection Device to prevent damage to the device and your computer.

If your Copy Protection Device is a USB device it must be plugged into one of your USB ports before you install the software.

- 2) Insert the CD into the CD drive of your computer. The Installation program should start up automatically. If it does not, double click the file **Setup.exe** in the CD root directory.
- 3) Click on the Install Programs button and then click on the Run HighRoad Key Updater button.
- 4) Once the Key Updater program opens, click on the Manual button, enter the Passwords (one per field across the page), and then click the Update button. After the update, click the Exit button.
- 5) The next time you start HighRoad, your new modules will be available for your use.
